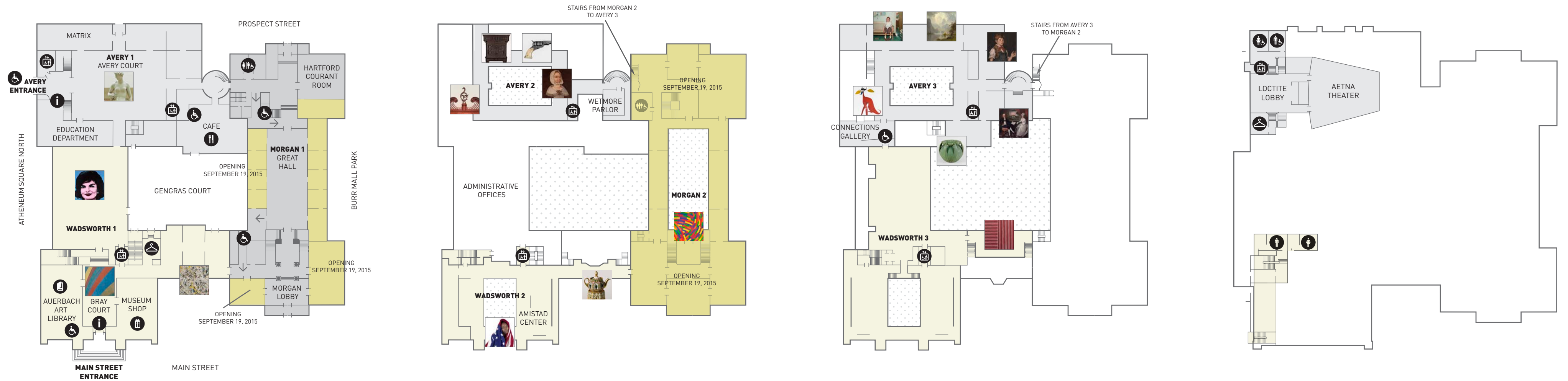

Guided highlights tours are offered Wednesday through Sunday at 1pm; guided tours of special exhibitions are offered Saturdays and Sundays at 2:30pm. All tours meet at the Information desk by the Museum Shop and are free with museum admission.

Self-guided tours of the collection and special exhibitions are available at any time. Use your mobile phone to access commentary at relevant stops in the galleries or ask to borrow a device at the Information desk by the Museum Shop. Selected tour stops are available in Spanish and American Sign Language.

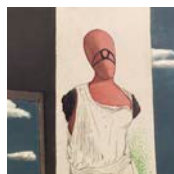

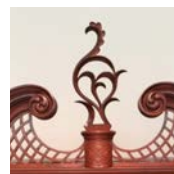

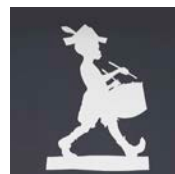

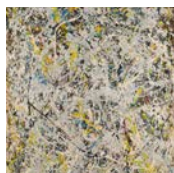

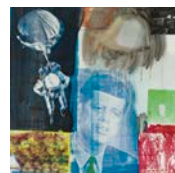

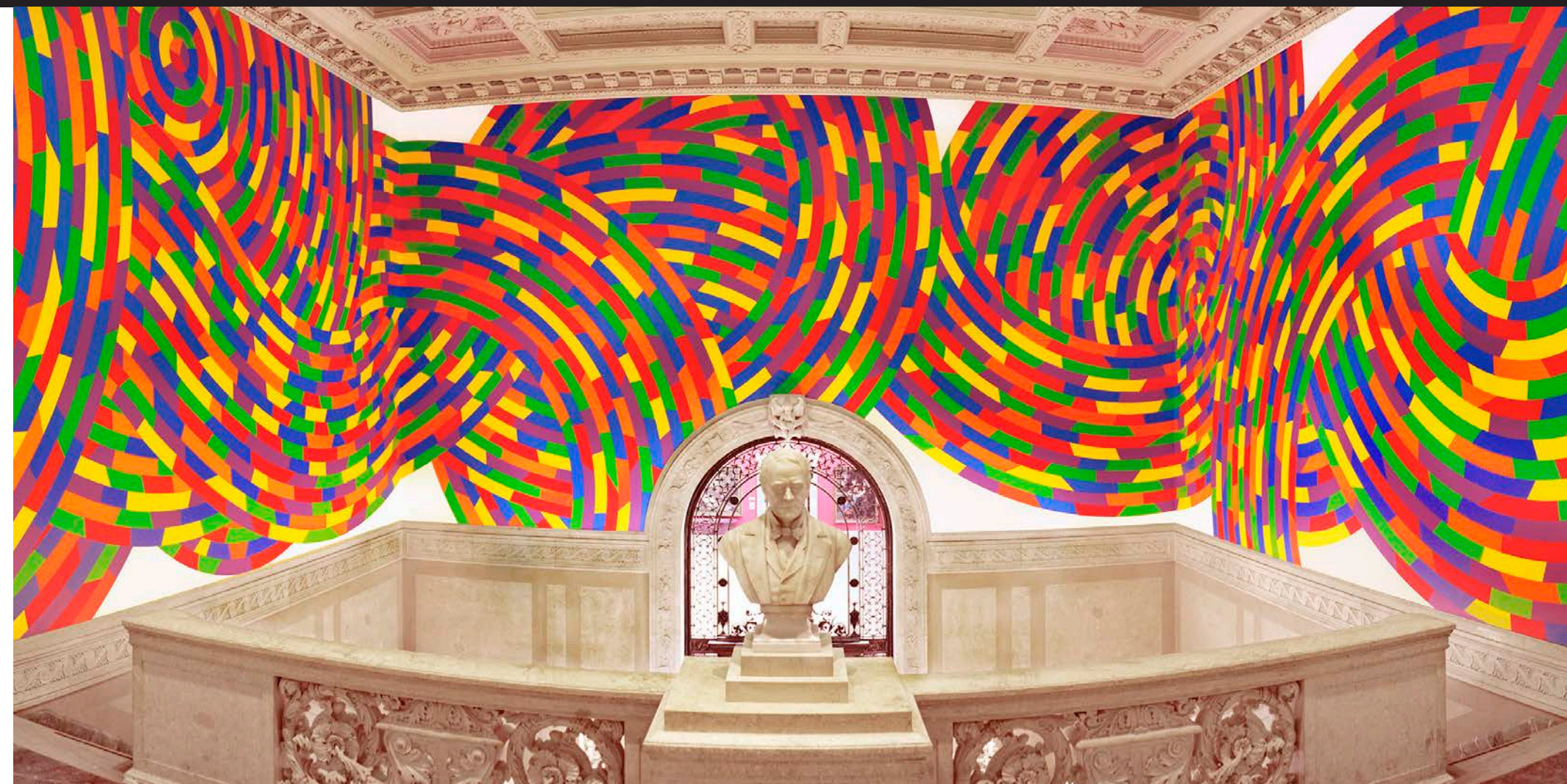
